

NCLA CJCLS Report for October 20, 2006

NCLA was on display at the Learning Resources Association annual conference in July at Wake Technical Community College. A special thank you goes to Caroline Walters and Peggy Quinn who were responsible for transporting and setting up the display and offering a door prize. As a result of the display and recruiting by Section members, eleven memberships were received during the conference.

The Executive Board of the Community and Junior College Libraries Section of the North Carolina Library Association met via conference call on October 11, 2006. All Board members were present.

The main topic of discussion dealt with the need to revisit the workshop topic due to the presenter moving out of state and no longer being available. The Board agreed to pursue information on a workshop dealing with the creation of online tutorials using free (or nearly free) software. Debbie Luck has contacted Kim Duckett, NCSU, and Lisa Norberg, UNC-CH to discuss the feasibility of this topic as a day-long workshop with hands-on activities. She will also contact Dave Goble at CPCC to ask about possible presenters from his staff. The Board is looking at a probable late winter to early spring workshop with the possibility of offering it as a pre-conference workshop at the annual Learning Resources Association conference in New Bern in March 2007. A more central state location was also discussed and will be considered.

The Board discussed possible contributions by the Section to leadership workshops. First choice by the Board was to pay half the tuition for a Section member to attend the Leadership Institute, but the Board also felt that a smaller contribution could be made to the NCLA sponsorship of the Emerging Leaders program.

Article VIII, Section 6 of the CJCLS by-laws dealing with a vacancy in the Executive Committee was discussed. Janice Pope, Vice-Chair, is preparing a comparison of this article with that of other NCLA sections.
