

NCLA College & University Section: Report for April 2006

Members of the Executive Committee of NCLA CUS met on April 4th in the beautiful Belk Library at Elon University to discuss possible topics for a CUS-sponsored workshop. The meeting was hosted by Vice-Chair/Chair-Elect Betty Garrison. After discussion of a number of possible topics, the Committee decided to send a survey out to the CUS membership to determine which of four proposed topics would be most preferred for a workshop. Additionally, other suggestions and membership participation will also be solicited as part of the survey. The four suggested topics are: 1) Starting an IM service; 2) Scholarly Communication issues in academic libraries; 3) Promoting Popular Reading Collections in academic libraries; & 4) Instructional Technology issues in academic libraries.

The survey is being compiled and will soon be sent out to the CUS membership. After the results are tabulated, other NCLA sections with similar or overlapping interests will be contacted to see if there is interest in joint sponsorship of the workshop.
