Quarterly Report to NCLA Executive Board – April 2010

The CJCLS Executive Committee met on February 10, 2010 via conference call. The committee discussed ways to increase membership. We agreed that if all executive committee members commit to recruiting at least 2 new members that would make a difference. Allen Mosteller agreed to be CJCLS's representative on the membership committee. After the meeting we obtained and reviewed an updated membership list to identify colleagues who are not currently members who we could approach about membership.

Several committee members expressed their willingness to attend a planning meeting for this in June in conjunction with CUS members.
