1. The print 2009 issue was mailed to members of record in early July 2010. Printing costs were up slightly even though we printed a significantly less number of copies than in 2008 [1700 vs. 2400]. This reflects the decline in membership of the Association.
2. The Board will soon be proofing the Spring/Summer 2010 issue which will include those reports from sections and roundtables that were submitted to the editor in the Spring of 2010 concerning their activities during the 2008-2009 report period.
3. Some periodic issues were observed with the web site: www.ncl.ecu.edu: Authors appear to be unable to submit revised manuscripts easily using the system, and some pdf files of past years disappeared. Editor and systems administrator looking into this. Hope to fix shortly.
4. Requested that North Carolina Library Association web site list an ad manager as a opportunity for new members [and old ones as well] to serve the association.
5. We continue to solicit manuscripts for future issues. Please encourage your colleagues.
6. Some members do not wish to receive print issues. Not sure how we can accomplish this other than to hand cull the membership list just for this mailing?
7. The Editorial Board did not meet in Greenville in July due primarily to travel restrictions. It was suggested that NCLA look into having some sort of internet conferencing software available, or that we use existing video-conferencing facilities. We will probably meet again at the next conference. So far using the electronic system for editing has proven successful but some members miss the face to face meetings.
