About NC Digital Library

Use your library card to check out and download bestselling audiobooks, e-books, music, and video. Nearly all titles can be transferred to portable devices, such as a MP3 player, an iPod, eReader, or a smart phone. Get started today by clicking on My Help for customized instructions for your computer or device or on the Guided Tour for a video that will walk you through the steps. Click on the Supported Portable Audio Devices icon on bottom right to determine if the equipment you own is compatible with NC Digital Library.

What You Need

- A computer with Internet access. Windows-based PCs can play or display audiobooks, eBooks, music and video. Adobe eBooks and MP3 e-audiobooks are also compatible with Mac computers.
- A valid Cumberland County Public Library card.
- To view Adobe eBooks, you need to download the free Adobe Digital Editions software available from the NC Digital Library Web site.

Getting Started

- Go to www.cumberland.lib.nc.us
- Click **Download a Book** on the left side
- Click on **North Carolina Digital Library**
- On the right, click on **Reading: All eBooks**

Step 1: Browse or search

- Look for the **Digital Media Search** box on the left hand side and designate a title, creator (author) or ISBN search.
- Click the box next to **Only show titles with available copies** to show only titles that are currently available to check out.
- Click **Advanced Search** for more searching options including format and language.
- Or, look below to browse by fiction genres or nonfiction subjects. To get a sneak peek and description, click on the title.
- Audiobooks will be in either a Mp3 or WMA format, while eBooks are in Adobe PDF or EPUB, Open PDF or EPUB, and Mobipocket eBook format. Check to make sure that the item you are downloading is in the format you need.

Step 2: Check out

- Click **Add to My NCDL eBookBag** on the right side of the page. You may add up to five titles to your eBookBag and keep them there for no more than 30 minutes before checking out. However, please note that you can only check out four titles at a time. If the **Add to My NCDL eBookBag** link is not available, the book is checked out, but you can still place a hold by clicking the **Hold Requests** button.
- Click **Proceed to Checkout**.
- Select **Cumberland County** and enter your library card number when prompted.
- Click **Confirm check out**.

Step 3: Download

- Click **Download** to transfer the file(s) to your computer.
- If this is your first download with NC Digital Library and you do not have **Adobe Digital Editions**, it will offer you a link to download the software. Select what you want to install and where to save the file on the computer. Once downloaded, Adobe Digital Editions will prompt you to authorize your computer and create an **Adobe ID**. This allows you to transfer your eBook from your computer to your device. Both **Adobe Digital Editions** and the eBook device must be activated with the same **Adobe ID** in order to transfer DRM-protected Adobe eBooks to the device.
- After you have downloaded **Adobe Digital Editions**, click **Download** to transfer the file to your computer.

- Select **Open** to have your title open directly into Digital Editions. Select **Save** to save the file to your computer.
- To transfer the eBook to your device, simply plug your device into the computer. Drag and drop the file to the device that will show up in the left pane of **Adobe Digital Editions**.

Note: An Overdrive “App” is available for many devices such as the iPhone and Android that will allow you to download directly onto your device once you’ve created your Adobe ID.

Frequently Asked Questions

How do I know if my device is compatible?

An up-to-date list of compatible devices can be found by clicking **Supported Portable Audio Devices** on the right hand side, under **Library Resources** within North Carolina Digital Library

How many items can I check out?

Though you can add up to five titles to your eBookBag, you will only be able to check out four titles at a time.

How do I return Adobe eBooks early?

To return Adobe eBooks early:

- Open **Adobe Digital Editions**.
- Select the **Library View** icon in the upper left corner. The Adobe Digital Editions library is displayed.
- Under the **Bookshelves** heading, select **Borrowed**.
- Click the eBook you want to return.
- Click the **Item Options** arrow in the upper left corner of the selected eBook.
- Select **Return Borrowed Item**.
- Click **Return** to verify that you want to return the title.
- The eBook is returned to the library collection. Once you return a title, you are free to download another title, up to your limit of four.

Can I renew the items I have checked out?

You may not renew items, but you may check them out again if there is no other request pending.

Can I get a list of only eBooks that are currently available to check out?

Under **Digital Media Search**, click on **Advanced Search**. Under **Format**, choose one of the types of eBooks. Click the box next to **Only show titles with copies available**, then click **Search**.

What happens when I place an item on hold?

When you place an item on hold, it will be reserved for you to check out when it becomes available. You will receive an email when the item is available. The item will be held for three days from the date of the emailed notice.

How many items can I place on hold at the same time?

You can place up to five titles on hold at a time.

How do I cancel a hold?

Log into your account by clicking **My NCDL Account** at the top of the page. Click **My Hold Requests** to view a list of titles currently placed on hold. Click **Remove** next to the title you wish to cancel.

What is My Wish List?

The wish list is for titles you do not plan to checkout or reserve at this time, but would like to consider for checkout or reserving at a later time.

What is My NCDL Account?

Use this section to track titles checked out and reserved. NC Digital titles are not recorded in your normal library card account though your library card number is needed to access your NCDL account.

Can I get overdue fines on eBooks?

No, eBooks will expire on their specified dates. They can never become overdue.

Can I download directly to my Internet Ready Device?

An App is available for many devices such as the Android and iPhone/iPad that will allow you download directly to your device once you’ve created your Adobe ID. This capability is currently not available for devices such as the Nook or Sony eReader.
