

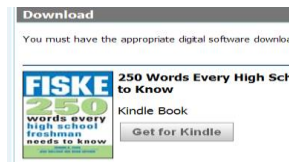
# Kindle & North Carolina Digital Library eBooks

You must have a current New Hanover County Public Library card and an Amazon account to begin. You can read Kindle format eBooks on your Kindle device, free reading app, or Kindle Cloud Reader.

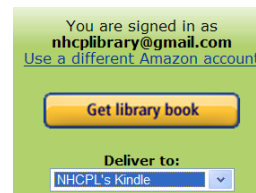


## Check out an eBook for Kindle!

1. Go to NHCPL homepage: [www.nhclibrary.org](http://www.nhclibrary.org) and select **North Carolina Digital Library**  
**OR go directly to NCDL website: <http://ncdigital.lib.overdrive.com>**
2. Select **Login** (on the left)
3. Select **New Hanover County Public Library** and enter **14 digit library card number**
4. There are many ways to search for a book: Basic, Advanced, Browse by Collection  
Make sure the book is in **Kindle format, look for this symbol:**
5. I suggest using **Advanced search**:  
select *Format Kindle*  
select *Only show titles with copies available*
6. Each book will display 2 out of 3 options:
  1. **Add to My NCDL eBookBag** (This means there is a copy available and you can check it out!)
  2. **Hold Requests** (All copies are checked out and you want to place a hold. You will be asked for an **email address** and will be emailed when the book is available for you to check out. You will have **3 days** to login and check the book out.)
  3. **Add to Wish List** (Doesn't matter if the book is available or not, you can still add it to a wish list. – A list of books you want to check out or place on hold at a later time.)
7. Select **Add to My NCDL eBookBag**
8. Select **Proceed to Checkout**
9. Select **Confirm Checkout**
10. Click on **“Get for Kindle.”**



11. You will then be directed to the Amazon.com website (*Note: By signing in to your Amazon account you are giving Amazon access to your information regarding Kindle format NHC library book check outs.*)
12. **A.** If you are NOT signed in to your Amazon account yet:
  - Select **“Get library book”**
  - Sign in to your Amazon.com account
  - Choose your Kindle device or reading application for delivery of your title (*some people have multiple devices*) and select **“Continue”**
12. **B.** If you are already signed in to your Amazon.com account:
  - Choose your Kindle device or reading application under **“Deliver to”**
  - Select **“Get library book”**



13. If you have an active **Wi-Fi connection**, the book will automatically be delivered to your Kindle! Library books will NOT be delivered via your Kindle's 3G connection.
14. **If you do not have an active Wi-Fi connection**, you may instead choose to load your library books via USB. Plug Kindle into your computer (Mac and Windows compatible) and select **“Download Now”** *More details available on Amazon website.*

## Kindle & North Carolina Digital Library: eBook FAQs

Read library eBooks on your Kindle, free reading app, or Kindle Cloud Reader.



- 1. Do I have to use my computer first or can I download them directly to my Kindle?** You must check the books out using your computer and send to Kindle using Wi-Fi or USB connection. 3G internet will NOT work.
- 2. How many can I check out?** – 4 total checkouts at a time (includes eAudiobooks)
- 3. How long can I check them out?** – 2 weeks.
- 4. Will I be notified before the loan expires (due date)?** Yes. Three days before the end of the loan period, Amazon will send a courtesy reminder email.
- 5. Late fees?**- No late fees
- 6. How do I return them?** – No need to return, the eBook will “expire.”

**7. Can I return the book early?**- Yes. Login to your Amazon account. Select “Your Account” (near top right of screen). Select “Manage Your Kindle” (near middle right of screen) Click on the “+” symbol next to any title to view due (expiration) date. To the right of the book select “Actions.” There you will see “Return this book.”

- 8. Can I renew?**- No. You can check the book out again if it's available. If not, you can place a hold request.
- 9. What happens to my notes and highlights after a loan expires?** You can access notes and highlights through [kindle.amazon.com](http://kindle.amazon.com) even after a book expires. If you check the book out again all of your notes and highlights will appear in the book as before the loan expired.
- 10. How many Kindle format eBooks are in NC Digital Library?** – Over 4,000
