

## **Website Committee**

### **July 2010 Report**

The NLCA Website Committee provided a second training session in the Drupal-based site to section and roundtable Web administrators on July 9 at the State Library in Raleigh. Six individuals attended.

In early July, we added a volunteer form to the Website so that members can volunteer to work with specific sections and roundtables and with other areas of the association. During the first two weeks of the form's availability, seven members submitted forms, and these names have been forwarded to the appropriate section and roundtable chairs.

In mid July, we added an RSS feed to the Website so that individuals can get updates on library news, NCLA calendar events, position openings, and changes to the NCLA website.

We have also begun tracking usage of the Website with Google Analytics. From July 1 to July 18, we had 853 visits and 4,063 page views. We hope that the information provided by Google Analytics will help us better understand how people use the Website and thus help us improve the Website.
